## Strengthening liberal dental practice

- The Liberal professions are a pillar of any free society.
- For the dentist liberal practice means:
- Free choice of treatment, freedom of association, free competition, free choice of doctor and responsibility for our own professional conduct.
- In the interest of their patients, dentists are committed to ethical and legal principles when exercising their profession.
- Currently dentists are caught up in the conflicting demands of a sweeping, often state driven desire to regulate, the needs and wishes of patients and the interests of liberal practice.
- The European Regional Organisation of the FDI affirms its longstanding goal of building and preserving "liberal dental practice" not least for the sake of our patients. This is the focus of our work in the ERO and its member countries.
- The European Regional Organisation of the FDI calls upon political decision-makers in our member countries to strengthen the role of the liberal professions; it is of vital importance, moreover, to enhance decisively the general conditions for exercising liberal professions in the field of health.
